Description of wine, vineyards, winemaking etc. :

Repositioning *Retsina Wine* (Appellation by Tradition) in a new quality context, we have meticulously selected grapes of *Roditis* variety which grow on the high slopes of Aegialia.

Combining these low-yield grapes with state-of-the art wine – making technology, and a carefully calculated quantity during the fermentation process, approximately 0,3 gr/lit of untreated resin from the *Pinus halepensis* variety of pine tree, we succeed.

The result is a refreshing wine balanced perfectly between pine and grapes –its citrus expression co-existing with its aromatic pine resin on equal terms.

Ritinitis Nobilis '98 obtained the Silver Medal in the 1st International Wine Competition in Thessaloniki (under the auspices of O.I.V.).
