White with golden reflections, soft, vivid fruity aroma with a velvety taste. The total is harmonious, easy to drink and appealing at the same time very delicate. In the mouth the wine develops into multilevels with an exceptional first taste and wonderful balance between alcohol level and acidity creating a vigorous, fruity, food friendly, full, sensuous wine with a round palate and long finish.

Over the years VILLARE EMERY has received several awards from international wine competitions. In 2005 it received the Gold Medal from the International Wine Competition in Thessaloniki in Greece and also received a special award since it got the highest score from the white indigenous grape variety Athiri. Last but not least VILLARE EMERY got another distinction this year from the wine competition that was held parallel to the wine trade fair in Dusseldorf Germany, PROWEIN 2005

Note: The name **VILLARÉ** originates from Foulk de Villaré, of French descent, Great Knight of the battalion of St John of Rhodes and Malta (1305)
