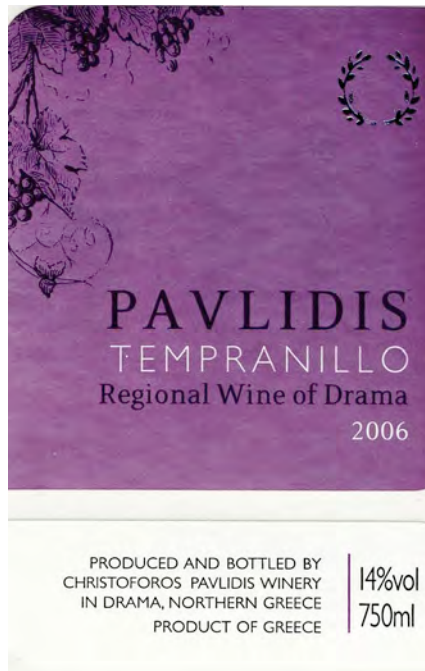


Ktima Pavlidis Tempranillo 2007



The Pavlidis Estate is nestled in a valley in the region of Drama in Northern Greece, at the foot of Mount Falakro. Christoforos Pavlidis had been searching for prime grape-growing land when he found this valley 1998, where he planted two vineyards, Kokkinogia and Perichora.

In the lower altitudes of the vineyards, the soil is largely red clay, turning to limestone and marl in higher grounds. The vineyards are planted to Sauvignon Blanc, Assyrtiko and Chardonnay for the whites, and Syrah, Agiorgitiko for the reds; the estate also makes a Tempranillo-based Rosé.
