Mercouri Coma Berenices 2009

Located in the western Peloponnese, near ancient Olympia, the Mercouri Estate has been producing wine and olive oil for 150 years. Theodoros Mercouri planted the first vineyards with Refosco cuttings he had imported from Friuli. His Refosco-based wines—once known locally as “Mercouri”—proved very popular elsewhere in Europe and were easily exported; trade ships could dock in the winery’s adjoining bay.

The estate underwent large-scale modernization in 1987, with the 4th generation, brothers Vassilis and Christos Kanellakopoulos, now heading operations. Today, the Mercouri Estate expands over 180 acres including the Mercouri family residence. Their repertoire of varietals has also expanded, with more than 15 indigenous and international varietals planted.
